

**Interment of Ashes Plot**  
**PCC Regulations**  
*Revised 2019*

1. The licence is granted in perpetuity.
2. The only memorial shall be stone.
3. Stones and inscriptions must be in a form and design approved by the PCC of St Mary Selly Oak. For this reason it is recommended that stones be obtained from Waterhouse and Co (0121 772 0747).
4. Dimensions of the stones are to be 46cm x 46cm x 5cm and are to be fashioned from South African dark grey granite.
5. All stones must be laid horizontally.
6. The licensees undertake not to do anything detrimental to any part of the churchyard.
7. No free-standing pots are allowed. Flowers or pot plants may only be placed in a receptacle incorporated in the memorial stone.
8. Planting in the grassed area is not permitted.
9. The PCC reserves the right to remove any spent flowers or plants.
10. Regulations and charges are reviewed annually by PCC. Fees for the current year are set out below.
